GENERAL HEALTH – is the bull in good health to the best of your knowledge on date of inspection		
MOUTH/JAW SETTING - Correct dentition, do the teeth make proper contact with the dental pad of the upper jaw?		
EYES – is there any evidence of cataract or microphthalmia?		
HEART – are there any signs of heart damage/failure to function correctly?		
LUNGS - are there any signs of lung damage/failure to function correctly?		
LEGS – are there any signs of abnormal positioning or gait?		
FEET – are there any signs of abnormal positioning or badly formed/cracked hooves		
TESTICLES – are the testicles of equal size with normal conformation and consistency for this age of bull?		
SCROTAL MEASUREMENT – MANDATORY Measurement in centimetres of the circumference of the testicles at the widest part of the scrotum is:	cms	
DNA TESTING : a sample of hair is to be pulled from the tail of the bull being inspected and inserted in the sample collector provided
